International Robotics Days 2022

General Rules

- Each competitor accepts the responsibility of reading and obeying the rules of the category they are attending.
- During the competition, the light level in the competition area and the location of the tracks will be such that the competition can be watched easily. Contestants' objections regarding these issues will not be accepted.
- Tracks are made professionally by our team and related companies. The competent authority for the suitability of the tracks for the competition is the referee committee. The primary factor to be taken into account in the evaluation of the objections regarding the track and its surroundings will be whether the competition situation is ensured under equal conditions between the competitors or not.
- Robot owners and schools entering the competition area cannot engage in acts that humiliate or disturb the opponent or the referee during, before or after the competition. Competitors exhibiting these behaviors will be **disqualified from all categories**. In addition, their right to compete in the next organizations will be taken away.
- All spectators and competitors in the organization area are obliged to abide by the general moral rules. The penalty for verbal or physical discussion with the opposing competitor, referee or spectator will be **to be taken out of the competition area through security guards**.
- Competitors agree to follow the directions of the category judges and coordinators during the competition. And if they have any objections to the rules, they submit this objection to the **Supreme Arbitration Board** by petition.

The final decision is made by the evaluation board and the contestants do not have the right to object to this result.

- METU Robotics Society has the right to take photos and videos at competitions and seminars during the International METU Robotics Days. **No copyright claims can be made on these materials after the competition.**
- The use of any UAV within the Culture and Congress Center, where competitions will be held during the International METU Robotics Days, is forbidden.
- **METU Robotics Society has the right to make changes regarding the category rules until the day of the competition.** Competitors are responsible for checking the category rules regularly. In all cases not specified in the rules, the only authorized person is the category coordinators.
- All competitors who are in the competition area or interested in robotics during the competition/evaluation in all categories must wear their name badges on which their name and school/team name are written.
- Each competitor can win **one prize** in the same category, as a team member or as a solo participant.
